




The International Classical Oriental Medicine Seminar 2005 : UK



DIRECTIONS - from styles to Principles **An attempt to unify Oriental Medical understanding**

The search, discovery, study and practice of Oriental Medicine directly from the Classics:-

This seminar is being held in an attempt to unite practitioners of Oriental medicine, of all fields and all styles, by providing the basis of understanding practice and treatment, direct from the classical literature. This would allow participants of all levels to get a better grasp of how Oriental medicine was perhaps originally understood by those that wrote the Classic texts, so many millennia ago.

Edward Obaidey is a practitioner of Oriental medicine living in Japan. He uses many disciplines including acupuncture, massage/shiatsu and herbal medicine as his tools of treatment. Edward, following his teacher; Ikeda Masakazu (whose main book is now available in English, translated by Edward, having been edited for the past 8 years by Dan Bensky), has been trying to uncover the underlying understanding and unity in Oriental medicine derived from classical sources, for over 40 years. This is our opportunity to converge on something that has the potential to change the future of Oriental medicine. A clear unity where we can converse in the same language of Principles, and so form understanding with each other, to become more complete in our study and practice. You are welcome to be a part of this.

This seminar will be held at **Regent's College Conference Centre**: Inner Circle, Regent's Park, London, on Saturday and Sunday, **August 6th - 7th**, from 10.00am to 6:00 pm.
