Developmental Acupuncture: Micro- and Macro Skills for Expanding Treatment Possibilities in Clinical Practice

In this seminar, Edward sensei will guide attendees to gain greater understanding of their practice of acupuncture and moxibustion. He wants to empower students to develop their own treatment strategies that will be generally applicable in a variety of clinical situations. On Days 1 and 2, attendees can expect to learn classically-based theory from the **Nan Jing** and **Nei Jing** and to observe demonstrations and participate in hands-on practice of micro skills for treatment. Day 3 will involve integration of the micro skills into macro skills (the treatment itself). It is Edward sensei's goal that no attendee leaves the seminar without gaining a more solid foundation in classical theory and practical competence.

He is the founder of the Japanese Acupuncture and Moxibustion Skills Foundation and more recently the Rare Apricot Society, organizations dedicated to the practice and preservation of traditional Oriental Medicine.

He is privileged to have studied in apprenticeship under Misao Takenouchi sensei and then he has spent over 20 years studying extensively with renowned acupuncturist/herbalist Masakazu Ikeda sensei. Edward sensei's own clinic is a place of living, developing practice where many students (both Japanese and Western) have apprenticed and continue to apprentice. This community is generated by Edward sensei's obvious expertise, dedication, and delight in pursuing and transmitting understanding of this art.

Edward sensei is Ikeda sensei's main interpreter for his books, DVDs, and seminars. He translated **"The Practice of Japanese Acupuncture and Moxibustion: Classic Principles in Action"**, and he conceived, designed, and narrated **"The Art of Acupuncture"** DVD.
