Beyond Stagnations and Deficiency: Resolving Blockages in Patient and Practitioner

In this seminar, Edward sensei will consider the subject of blockages in the context of Oriental Medicine. From this perspective, blockages can exist in the patient as well as in the practitioner.



This seminar will investigate: 1] the meaning, manifestation, and treatment of Blood Stagnation, Accumulation Disease,

Concentrations, and Stagnation within Deficiency; and 2] blockages to learning and development in the practitioner.

Edward sensei will:

- •use the prism of the various Stagnations to illustrate understanding of pathology, symptoms and treatment.
- *draw on various classical sources, particularly Nan Jing, Su Wen, Ling Shu, Mai Jing, and Shang Han Lun.
- •discuss, demonstrate, and teach techniques and skills.
- •discuss sticking points and blockages in the development of the practitioner's skills and knowledge.

You, the practitioner, will:

- •learn to recognize, understand, diagnose and treat all types of stagnation and blockages in the context of symptoms and pathology.
- arrive at better understanding of the classical syndromes.
- develop the tools for continuing development and increased effectiveness in your practice.
- gain freedom to creatively select your own approach to best deal with the circumstances of the patient before you.
- learn & practice the skillful use of both fine needles and Chinese needles
- learn & practice effective point selection, needling techniques & moxibustion techniques.

It is Edward sensei's goal that no attendee leaves the seminar without gaining a more solid foundation in classical theory and practical competence.
